1. Organizational Background:

The German aid organization Kinderhilfswerk originally started working with children from poor and helpless families in the Lalmonirhat area after the war in 1971 and has been providing regular assistance since 1976. They provided assistance through the Lalmonirhat Mission, Bangladesh. Later, Kinderhilfswerk was registered by the District Social Welfare and NGO Affairs Bureau, Dhaka, Bangladesh. The donor organization Kinderhilfswerk stiftung global care Germany is still continuing their assistance. So that the poor students of this area can get quality education



Kinderhilfswerk is a non Government, nonprofit and non political organization. This organization is register by NGO Affairs Bureau and Ministry of Social Welfare, Bangladesh. This organization basically provides assistance to children though its sponsorship program. This organization generally helps poor, autistic and underprivileged families and their children in their education. It provides them cash support, food items, clothes, entertainment for their mental development, sports equipments, health care equipments, gifts and other necessities. It also works on provide clean water through tube wells, safe latrine installation, providing various relief items during disasters, rehabilitation, women's development etc.



2. Who gets help and how:

Lalmonirhat district is a district in the north of Bangladesh. This district is located on the banks of the two rivers Tista and Dharla. Every year, due to floods, extreme cold and unemployment, the common people live in great problems. They constantly struggle to survive due to lack of money and nutritious food. They are also deprived of the daily necessities of life. Therefore, the main objective is to help all these families and children to continue their education.

Currently, this work is being done through the "Child Sponsorship and Education" project. Currently, 226 students who are studying are being provided with various kinds of assistance through this project. Any child from a poor family who falls under the sponsorship policy of kinderhilfswerk can apply for this assistance. Some disabled children also receive this assistance.

3. The help they received:



Sponsored students received various assistance throughout the year in 2024. Out of the total

students, 25 were provided with food items every month, educational items, safety items, and special gifts different times of the year. 201 were provided with stipends (school TK-700/= and college TK-950/=) every month and educational items, health safety equipment, and special gifts different times of the year. Kinderhilfswerk invite the respected local government administration personals during each distribution.

Description of the materials:

Educational items: Notebook, pen, pencil, geometry box, colored pencils, pen box. etc.

Health safety equipment: Soap, toothpaste, nails cutters, toothbrush and bleaching powder. etc.

Special gifts: Food package-(given 226 sponsor students) rice, flour, pulse, salt, ors, fertilizer, vegetable seeds, soap. etc.

4. Distribution ceremony:

KHW, Lalmonirhat organized 3 distribution events in 2023-2024. Students, parents, government officials, local dignitaries and office staffs were present at the events.

Date: 11 December 2023

Distribution of stipends, sports equipment, special gifts among the sponsor students and gift items among those students who passed the SSC and HSC exams.



Date: 3 June-2024

Distribution ceremony of stipends, educational materials, health care materials, etc. among the sponsored students, sponsored by the organization.



Date: 25 September-2024

Distribution ceremony of monthly stipend, monthly food items, annual health care items, etc. among the students sponsored by the organization





5. Achievement and Developing:

Like every year, this year there are some achievements. Kinderhipswerk, Lalmonirhat always provides maximum support to the sponsor students in their studies. The students have been given 100% stipend. So that they can fully concentrate on their studies, they have been given necessary accessories along with the stipend. We can understand this only by looking at the pass rate of the school students. Because at the end of the year they are promoted to the new class. Similarly, those studying in college, university and other courses are also passed to a new semester or a new year. Also, every year in the board public examinations, the sponsored students of KHW, Lalmonirhat get good results. We are giving their list below. Currently, many KHW students are studying in good educational institutions and their studies are going well too.

There were various rides for young boys and girls at the fair. Various cake shops were set up at the fair. Circuses and motorcycle stunts are held to entertain the fair. Fishermen bring big fish from different places to this fair. The sons-in-law of the area take big fish for their in-laws' house. That is why this fair is also called Jamai (Son-in-law) fair. Cultural programs are also organized at the fair. Many talented artists of the country also come to sing songs. This event brightens everyone's hearts. This fair is a source of tradition and joy for this region.

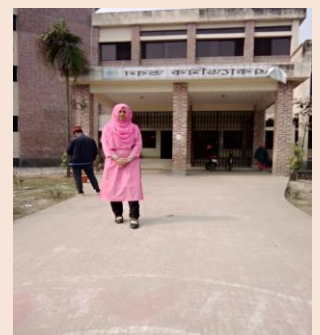


6. Developing Story:

Her father's income was very low and her mother was a housewife. KHW's help came as a blessing in her life. She passed her school final exam SSC and HSC from college. Then she got a chance to do BSC Nursing at the local Govt. Nursing Institute, Lalmonirhat. With



the help and support of her family and KHW, her studies are progressing. Her studies are going well. She is grateful to KHW. She hopes to pass and serve people through a good job. Along with that, she will be able to help her family. She asks for everyone's prayers. We wish her a bright future.

7. Success Story of the former sponsored children:

Name: Christina Soren-Reg no.-201-118:

Christina Soren- Reg no.-201-118, she is our former sponsored student. when her sponsorship application was submitted, her father did not had any job. Her mother was the only earner in their family. Christina Soren had an older sister; she had also started studying at that time. When Christina started getting help from KHW, she was in class two. They lived in the divisional city of Rajshahi. She started studying in a school there. There, her mother worked as a cook in an institution. Since they lived in a big city, they had to struggle a lot. With the help of KHW and her mother's income, she continued her studies. At one time, she passed the school final examination (SSC) and HSC from college. After that, she admitted a private nursing institute for Diploma in Nursing and Midwifery course. There, her hard study life began. With the help of her family and KHW, she continued her studies. Then she passed Diploma Nursing from a private nursing institute and completed her internship in March 2024 last year. We talked to her and came to know that she has been working in a big private hospital in Dhaka since last November 2024. Her family and the girl are very happy. She is helping her family. She is eternally grateful to KHW. She thanked KHW. We wish her all the best.



8. Where do the kids go to school?



Most of the sponsored children study in local schools and colleges. Sometimes they have to go far away from home for various reasons. Then they have to get admitted in a school-college or educational institution far away. The reasons are moving to another place due to their parents' work, admission from primary school to high school, for higher education, admission to an educational institution of their own choice, etc. The picture above shows Trimohan-201-172 and Soriful-201-174. They are taking teacher's lessons at 1 no. nowdabosh Govt. Primary School near their house at Barabari Union, Lalmonirhat Sadar, Lalmonirhat.

9. Disaster relief for flood victims at Baramchal and Tilagaon:

At the end of July 2024 there were heavy monsoon rain at the Sylhet region at Bangladesh. At the same time the rivers from up stream flows towards the downstream through Sylhet, Bangladesh made a heavy flood along with rain water and river over flown water at Sylhet region. About 5 million people are directly affected from this disaster. Some of our sponsor children families were directly affected out of this flood and sent us some photos and videos. We inquired the matter and reported to Global Care, KHW, Germany. After receiving the donor's commitment, we conduct the next activities as per the official rules of NGO Bureau, Bangladesh.



The most affected people, those who have received less assistance from Government and private sector they have been selected. Total 500 people from 500 families have been selected in this project, those people who earn their living by tea garden labor, day labor and other professionals those who have been extensive damage by the flood, who the Kinderhilfswerk's sponsored students and their families are directly affected by the floods, they are mainly our target group. Also other flood affected people of the area have also been involved under this food aid and awareness training. At Baramchal there are 120 sponsored students/families of SSS and 180 selected families and there were 200 beneficiaries in Tilagaon from local government's selection were given relief package and awareness training. Project Duration was 02-09-2024 to 30-11-2024.

Project Implementation:

Project Activities: As per the project plan, the project conducts with two ways. (A) Distribution of various food items and (B) Awareness training.

Relief Item:

Our distributed food aid and quantity: (rice-25kg, pulse-2kg, oil-2litter, salt-1kg, sugar-1kg, flour-5kg, samolina-1kg, biscuit-1box, ors-2box, soap-2pics, milk powder-1pac).

Distribution:



Distribution of various food items and awareness training: All the staffs of the project are working hard to provide emergency food assistance and awareness among the targeted 500 families as soon as possible. We knew how much they were suffering. Everyone in the project was sincere. First we meet the government officials there to involve them in the project. Exchange views with them about work. Schedule relief distribution and awareness training days. Kulaura sub district Officers and Baramchal and Tilagaon Union Parishad

Chairman and other officials were very helpful there. 300 distribution tokens were prepared at Baramchal. There, 120 sponsored students of SSS and 180 selected families of local government were given distribution tokens. Distribution and awareness training is held at two places on both the scheduled days. Their distribution date was 22-10-2024 and on that day distribution was done after awareness training. In Tilagaon too, distribution tokens are distributed in the joint selection of Union council, KHW and SSS. There too tokens were distributed among 200 families. The distribution date there was 23-10-2024 and on that day after awareness training was held on. Disaster specialist Mr. Shahid Kamal, he conducted this awareness training to the both places Baramchal and Tilagaon. Mr. Saumitra Karmakar (sub district women affairs officer) representative of sub district chief executive officer was present at the distribution ceremony of two unions. Both the chairmen of the two unions were present at the distribution ceremony of their unions and ward councilors were also present. They had a massive presence. One lunch package is distributed to each person at noon. Caps and T-shirts were pressed for fifty persons who were distributed to all the participants in the distribution program. 500 bags were printed for distribution. Goods for relief are procured from the local market of Baramchal. The goods are packed with the help of SSS officials. We see their excitement and joy at getting relief. We are also happy because we have faced all the challenges and have been able to provide relief items to the flood victims. KHW thank the union council chairman (two unions), sub district executive officer, sub district women affairs officer, disaster awareness specialist, SSS, transport workers and others.

The above mentioned person is a congenitally disabled person. His father is not alive but his mother is alive. He and his mother live in his brother's household. All of them have a total of three decimal of land, which is very little. They have a small hut made of wood, bamboo, tin. As he is physically challenged, his life is very difficult. He is not married. His brother and his sister-in-law are busy at work. His brother is a rickshaw van puller and his wife does housework. His brother's income is limited, with which he earns it is difficult to meet the expenses of the family. During the flood, their cottage was waist-deep in water. Had to cook and eat at a high place on the dam. Earlier he got disability allowance but now he doesn't get even that. KHW, Lalmonirhat while giving relief there saw his condition and included him in the relief list. He comes on the appropriate day and received relief materials. His speech was heard. He said he was very happy to receive this package. He doesn't have to worry about food for a month. Other members of his family will also benefit. He thanked everyone. We also wish him well.

10. Children's gathering 2024:



Like every year, a children's gathering was organized on December 19, 2024 to bring joy to the children. At that event, food items, educational materials, health care items, stipends, and gifts were distributed among the sponsored students of the organization. Finally, a cake was cut and celebrated in the presence of everyone on the occasion of Pre Christmas-2024. Students, parents, local dignitaries, neighbors, staffs, and committee members were present at the event. Everyone enjoyed the event.

11. Martyrs' Day and International Mother Language Day:

Like every year, 21 February 2024 was observed. This day is observed in memory of the great people who gave their lives for the language. Early in the morning, everyone starts the day by offering institutional and personal flowers at the memorial built for the martyrs of the language.



KHW, Lalmonirhat's sponsored students and staff all went barefoot to lay flowers at the memorial.

12. Feed project:



There are currently 25 feed students under the organization. They receive 1 packet of food items every month. The food items they receive include Rice-5 kg, pulses-500 grams, Soybean oil-500 ml, flour-2 kg, and Iodized salt-1 kg. etc.

Also gets other regular accompaniments:

Educational items: Notebook, pen, pencil, geometry box, colored pencils, pen box. etc.

Health safety equipment: Soap, toothpaste, nails clippers, toothbrush and bleaching powder. etc.

Special gifts: Food package-(given 226 sponsor students) rice, flour, pulse, salt, ors, fertilizer, vegetable seeds, soap. etc.
