How are the children developing? How is the work developing?

The children are mostly pursuing their studies in various hostels and with their families at their respective homes. Supervisor and wardens go to every house to inquire about the students studies and also visit the schools to keep them updated so that the students attend school properly. The project staff is supporting the beneficiary weak students of Akilpur for two hours in the office during school holidays so that they can get good results. Before the annual examination, supervisor and wardens visit the homes of the children to advise them on how to study to achieve good results.

What kind of help did the children receive?

The Primary School students, High School students, College/Nursing/Technical Training and University going students get their stipend/cash ration in January/2024, February/2024, June/2024, October/2024 and December/2024. With that sponsorship money they paid school fees and other essentials. If anyone has special needs for form fill up then they are assisted. In December/2024 all students get their festival clothes.

The present office of the project is at Nandanar (Akilpur) village of Baramchal Union. People of this village have a good mentality. Most of the people in the work area are followers of Islam. Hindu also has some people but less in number. Only project workers are among the Christians. The area has good transportation, electricity and internet access. But due to excess amount of iron in the water the people of this area suffer for fresh drinking water. The population of this area is very poor, eats day by day. There are 16 beneficiary students in this village. They all believe in Islam. People in this area celebrate festivals of different religions at different times.

(What do most of them do in their free time?)

In their free time, after fulfilling their parental and personal responsibilities, the beneficiary students pursue their hobbies according to their choice, some read story books, some sew, some learn music, some dance, some play musical instruments and some play sports. Others watch various educational program on television.

Were there any special treats or celebrations?

The children receive assistance in various ways. If someone is sick, they should be seen by a doctor and given first aid. Schools and college students are paid to fill up their form. Besides, the students are given various educational materials like notebooks, pencils, pens, rubbers. Bangladesh is a mother country of rivers so there are floods in this country every year. With the help of Kinderhilfswerk, Lalmonirhat, flood items and essential items were given to the people in the flood affected area as well as the beneficiary students through the organization.

(How do you celebrate Christmas with the children?)

We have celebrated Pre Christmas on December 18, 2024 with our project staff, committee members and the local Muslim children and with the people of Akilpur village near of our office. All the students celebrate Christmas and New Year with their parents in their own villages.



Case study-1

Rispa Layek ID Number 202- 024. The name of her village is Baithang Jalai, Police station Kulaura and District Moulvibazar. Father's name is Anil Layek and my mother's name is Niyoti Layek. Total members of her family are 6 people. This family is very poor. Her mother is a housewife. Her father's meager income did not support the family. Their houses had mud walls and no electricity. There was no good communication system. The distance of their village from sub district Kulaura is 7 kilometers. Her parents want their children to get a good education. It was very difficult to educate their children on the father's meager income so they needed help. Finally at Baramchal got an opportunity under Kinderhilfswerk. She comes to the hostel and does her studies. In 2012 she got good results in SSC exam from Baramchal high school and college. Then admitted to Sylhet Model School and College and passed the HSC examination in 2014. She graduated from Moulvibazar Government College of Honors in philosophy. Later she obtained her postgraduate honors in the Department of Masters in Philosophy from the renowned ancient Murarichand College (M.C) College, Sylhet. Now she wants to stand on her own feet after completing her studies. Now she is working as a store assistant officer in a company called Prangon Plastic Industries Limited (Sremangal). She is very happy that Kinderhilfswerk has made it this far in her life. It was not possible for her parents to make her study so far. She and her family are all grateful.



Case Study-2

Christina Suchiang ID number 202- 121. Her Father's name is Rolin Marlia and mother's name is Runa Suchiang. Their total family members are 7 people. She has two brothers and two sisters. Among their siblings, Christina Suchiang is the third child. Her village name is Katajungallam punji, Union No. 8 South, Police station Baralekha, and District Moulvibazar. She is one of the beneficiary Kinderhilfswerk students. She is a child from a poor family. Her father is a farmer and mother is a housewife. The land where they lived in was very small. Her father is the only breadwinner in the family. It was not possible for him to support the family. Since her childhood, she was very interested in studies and pays attention. She was also interested in entertainment. She passed S.S.C. in 2012 from Baramchal High School & College and passed H. S. C. in 2015 from Darika Paul Women Degree College. In 2016, she was admitted to the college as a Bachelor of Arts. During graduation she has a three years diploma in nursing paramedical college from Sylhet. After completing her training course in December 2024, she is currently working at Medicity General Hospital, Bianibazar. She and her family are eternally grateful to Kinderhilfswerk.



Case Study–3

Bonna Longdoh ID No. 202-027, Father's name is Khalur Palla and my mother's name is Te Longdoh. Punji name Shilua Punji, Police station Juri, District Moulvibazar. She has six siblings in total. She is the youngest of all the siblings. She is a girl from a poor family. Her father left them when she was child. Her father did not keep track of them. All the responsibilities in the family fell on her mother's shoulders. Her mother took care of all the siblings and took care of all the expenses of their family. After the death of their Headman of their village the new headman did not look kindly on the village people. At that time many people lose their sense of humor. So her mother was forced to work in someone else's house. Because at that time their mother was just planting betel leaf plants. And it takes about 3-4 years for the betel plant to grow. So her mother decided to go and work in another village. One of her brothers worked in another betel leaf farm and another brother worked in their own betel leaf farm. Her mother went to work with her sisters for work in another village. After staying in another village for a few years, she returned to her own village with everyone. Even after coming home, they have to work hard. Her mother is very keen to educate her younger daughter. But her mother did not have that ability. So she approached Kinderhilfswerk to help her daughter with her studies. The incharge of Kinderhilfswerk decided to help her after considering all that the girl is very focused on studies. All the information was taken and after a few years she got to help. In 2012 she got good results in SSC exam from Baramchal high school and college. In 2014 she got good results in HSC exam from Eakub Tajul Women Degree College. Then she graduated from Moulvibazar Government College of Honors in Sociology. Later she obtained her postgraduate honors in the Department of Masters in Sociology from the renowned ancient Murarich and College (M.C) College, Sylhet. Now she is working as a social worker at Compassion project in Fultola Punji. She and her mother are forever grateful to Kinderhilfswerk for helping her with her studies for a long time. That study could not have been established without the support of Kinderhilfswerk. Pray for her to have more success in life.
